The county was established in 1858 and named in honor of Augustin Smith Clayton (1783–1839), who served in the United States House of Representatives from 1832 until 1835.

Clayton County is included in the Atlanta metropolitan area, and it is the fifth most-populous county in the state. Clayton County is the home of Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport, the busiest airport in the world by total passengers.
